SUBJECT: PeaceHealth Generator Controls Upgrade Project

In addition to the Pharmacy, Imaging, and Mammography renovation projects, PeaceHealth is planning a generator controls system upgrade. As City Council may recall, there are two sets of emergency backup generators at the Hospital. This project entails removing and replacing the generator controls in the old section of the Hospital with new controls consistent with those used for the new Hospital addition generators. In order to ensure uninterrupted backup power, a temporary generator will be in place for the duration of the project.

This project is being fully funded and managed by PeaceHealth, with an estimated cost of \$300,000.
