Port Dock Vendor Program Update

Staff advertised requesting bids for both the Food and Dock Vendor programs in December, and were planned to be opened on January 19, 2022. However, due to the recent surge in the COVID-19 Omicron variant and with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) raising the Travel Health Notice to Level 4 for cruise, some uncertainty has been introduced into the 2022 cruise season. I have heard from several prospective bidders that delaying this opening for a month would all them to make a more educated decision on their bid. Therefore, staff issued an addendum for both the Port Food Vendor Program and Port Dock Vendor Program Request for Bids which extends the Bid Opening date to February 18th, 2022. Staff now anticipates awarding the leases at the regular City Council Meeting of March 3, 2022.

We will continue to keep your office updated as this situation continues to develop.
