In fulfillment of the Measurable Goals laid out in the CY 2022 grant proposal, the Ketchikan Senior Center provided the following services and activities during the year:

1. To provide 10,000 rides to Ketchikan Senior Center clients, offering access to critical community services and activities.

1st quarter of 2022: The Ketchikan Senior Center provided 1,824 rides.

2. To provide 15,000 hot lunches to Ketchikan Senior Center clients, offering a nutritious meal, socialization, and a safety check. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all senior citizens are eligible for home delivered meals at this time.

1st **quarter of 2022:** The Ketchikan Senior Center provided 4,502 complete, nutritious meals.
