Well Fall is coming swiftly and services have picked up this month as work is slowing down, people renewing their food stamp applications and other challenges. Due to continued and generous giving we are able to keep our different closets and food pantry stocked. We feel that it is always important that we are able to provide the items and services that we advertize at all times.

The Walmart grant of \$2000 helps to keep our food pantry stocked. We have had wonderful donations of diapers & wipes this month. We had a case of toilet paper donated from the Salvation Army. Each week we receive donations from people in our community, it is such a blessing to get a call from someone who has something to donate.

The Food Commodity program (A Federal food program) provides a wide variety of foods from meat, vegetables, beans, Mac & Cheese, rice, chili, canned meats and other staples. Clients can pick these items each month on the 4th Thursday of the month.

Our new Homeless assistance grant (BHAP) provides rent/utilities/sec dep for those who are under eviction, disconnect or homeless. We receive \$100,000 each year to assist our community. Thanks to all our volunteers that keep our services going smoothly. Thanks to all our donors who keep us solvent!
