SUBJECT: Electrical Outage of August 3, 2022

On Wednesday August 3, 2022, at 6:53 AM, an outage affected all electric services north of Ketchikan and parts of Gravina Island. This outage was caused by a suspected avian contact with the 34.5kV system at or near Lewis Reef Substation.

The suspected avian contact caused protective relaying at Baily Powerplant to open the 34.5kV North Tie Breaker disconnecting power from three substations: Lewis Reef, North Point Higgins, and Ward Cove. No equipment was damaged during the event.

KPU operators and crews identified the issue and immediately began power restoration. The power restoration process took additional time due to the nature of the outage location. Initially 1,884 customers were affected by the outage. Within one hour twenty-one minutes, power was restored to all customers.

SUBJECT: Electrical Outage of August 8, 2022

On Saturday, August 6, 2021, at 6:07 AM, an outage affected three (3) substations and electric services in Ketchikan. An avian contact with the 34.5kV system within the Ketchikan substation caused the outage.

The contact caused protective relaying to open system 12.46kV feeders and 34.5kV tiebreakers causing a power outage.

KPU operators and crews quickly identified the issue and immediately began power restoration. The power restoration process takes time because generation has to be restored in a controlled manner; feeders in the system are closed in a step-by-step process to restore system stability.

Initially, the outage affected 5,007 customers. Within one hour thirty-six minutes, power was restored to all customers.
