Enclosed you will find the required financial report for the past quarter, July -September of the fiscal year. The profit and loss statement for the quarter will give you a snapshot of RSDS finances as well as where funds are generated for the organization and how that money is spent. RSDS has proven an excellent manager of controlling costs and managing funding.

RSDS has been asked to be a part of the steering committee for the Alaska Sustainable Fisheries Trust. Among other activities, the Trust has donated thousands of pounds of salmon to communities around the State of Alaska. RSDS has accepted 1,000 ponds of frozen sockeye salmon to distribute in the Ketchikan community. RSDS has passed out salmon to WISH, PATH, RYC, our own Elders participating in our program as well as a number of food insecure families. RSDS has extended well beyond the doors and the initial mission to encompass the greater Ketchikan community in food distribution. The surplus food Safeway donates to RSDS is shared by other organizations and families needing a little help making ends meet.

RSDS is a part of the Ketchikan Nonprofit Collaborative. As part of this collaborative, RSDS has assisted in hosting a forum for City Council and Borough Assembly candidates to give voters an insight to the people running for office and the issues facing our community.

In the past quarter, RSDS has loaned more than 165 pieces of medical equipment such as walkers, wheelchairs, canes, bed rails and other items to community members at no charge. The medical closet saves members of our community hundreds of dollars with this loan closet.

RSDS's mission is to provide a safe place for Elders and persons with different abilities. This organization stretches our arms to encompass the entire community, far beyond our main mission. We feed people. We give people clothing, household goods and supplies through the Thrift Store. We help our community thrive.
